



22 MILES TO EXPLORE

The Mill Creek Water Trail is a 22 mile trek through Jackson County, offering recreational kayaking and canoeing. The trail begins at the scenic Cedar Lakes Conference Center, home of the Mountain State Art & Craft Fair. It continues through the picturesque town of Ripley. Paddling down the creek one can stop at Rollins Lake, a popular fishing area. From there one can step out at the Jackson County Fairgrounds and explore the beautiful acreage and buildings. Next stop will be Millwood where Mill Creek joins the Ohio River. Mill Creek is a great learning experience for beginners. Bring your kayak or canoe and explore Jackson County!
